STAYING SAFE ON-LINE AND IN THE REAL WORLD

Founded in 1985, the Missing Children's Network is the only non-profit organization in Quebec dedicated to the search for missing children and to the prevention of their abduction and disappearance. As adults, we may hesitate to discuss the risks of abuse and abduction with our children, feeling that we may frighten them or destroy their sense of joy of the world.

Safety education helps build children's confidence and critical thinking skills, and prepares them for dangerous situations that they may encounter when home alone, surfing the Net, traveling to-and-from school or getting lost in public places.

Objective | Empower parents with the skills and knowledge that will assist them in building their children's confidence and critical thinking skills, thus preparing them for potentially dangerous situations should they arise. As well as provide parents with the tools that will keep their children safer both online and in real life.

Content | This interactive seminar provides parents with a number of concrete examples that will assist them in teaching their children how to stay safe in everyday situations:

- How and why children fall victim to abduction and exploitation;
- How to minimize the opportunity and risks;
- How to practice safety skills using what-if scenarios;
- Identifying trustworthy people and safe places;
- Enhance children's ability to recognize potential dangers on the Internet and the measures to take in order to minimize risks;
- Encourage children to report any form of victimization to a trusted adult;
- Emphasize the public nature and permanence of sent images/texts, the legal implications of distributing inappropriate material, and the disruption it may cause in their life;
- Help protect children from cyberbullying.
